
Branding and Packaging for SHG Products

Golden Environment Day

World Environment Day is the largest global platform for environmental public outreach, and millions celebrate it across the globe. According to the official website of World Environment Day, the theme on June 5, 2023, will focus on solutions to plastic pollution under the campaign #BeatPlasticPollution hosted by Côte D'Ivoire.

Led by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), World Environment Day was first marked on June 5, 1973, during the Stockholm Conference on the Human Environment. At that time, the theme was 'Only One Earth'. World Environment Day aims to bring together millions of people from across the globe, engaging them in the effort to protect and restore the Earth.

According to the UN, "more than 400 million tonnes of plastic is produced every year worldwide, half of which is designed to be used only once. Of that, less than 10 per cent is recycled. An estimated 19-23 million tonnes end up in lakes, rivers and seas annually. Microplastics find their way into food, water and air. It is estimated that each person on the planet consumes more than 50,000 plastic particles per year and many more if inhalation is considered."

We produce hundreds of millions of tons of plastic every year, most of which cannot be recycled. It's obvious that we need to use less plastic, move towards environmentally sustainable products and services and come up with technology that recycles plastic more efficiently.

The plastic industry was established in India in 1957 when the country began producing polystyrene. India's plastic industry has grown rapidly since its inception and is now a key player in global plastics production, comprising more than 20,000 processing units. It is a multi-billiondollar industry and a major contributor to India's economy, employing some four million people. It is also a global supplier, with India's polymer exports totalling some 1.5 million metric tons in 2021.

Indonesia, India, the U.S., Brazil and Thailand are the top five producers of ocean plastic pollution and are responsible for 43 per cent of the global total. Indonesia generates around 1.4 million tonnes of ocean plastic each year, 16 per cent of the world total. India is slightly behind Indonesia, accounting for 13 per cent of the global total.

To follow SaalumaradaThimmakka

Also known as Aala MaradaThimmakka, is an Indian environmentalist from the state of Karnataka, noted for her work in planting and tending to 385 banyan trees along a forty-five-kilometre stretch of highway between Hulikal and Kudur. She has also planted nearly 8000 other trees. With the support of her husband, she found solace in planting trees.

She received no formal education and worked as a casual labourer in a nearby quarry. Her work has been honoured with the National Citizen's Award of India. Her work was recognised by the Government of India and she was conferred with Padma Shri in 2019.

A U.S. environmental organisation based in Los Angeles and Oakland, California called Thimmakka's Resources for Environmental Education is named after her. Central University of Karnataka has announced an honorary doctorate for Thimmakka in the year 2020. Honoured with 15 Awards for 112 year old living legend.


Optimization Techniques for Supply Chain Management




Farm Based Livelihood Opportunities for Rural Youth

Impact Assessment of SVEP Blocks

National Institute for MSME (ni-msme) recently embarked on a comprehensive Impact Assessment of the Start-up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP) in four blocks of Andhra Pradesh from 08 to 17 June 2023. The project involved a series of field visits and interactions with the program's beneficiaries and stakeholders. Two young professionals, Mr. K. Dhanraj, SEM and Mr. K. Ramakiran, SEE visited different blocks to gather information for analyzing the program's impact on the ground. Mr. K. Dhanraj visited the Rajam and Srungavarapukota of Vizianagaram District Blocks. Simultaneously, Mr. K. Ramakiran, visited Tanuku, West Godavari and Kuppam, Chittoore Blocks. Their primary objective was to gather data and insights that would contribute to the assessment of the impact created by SVEP.

During the visits, a total of 16 focused group discussions (four per block) and 80 Key informant interviews (20 per block) were conducted at various locations within each block. These discussions and interviews provided valuable perspectives from different stakeholders and beneficiaries of the programme. The fieldwork was successfully completed under the guidance of Mr. K. Surya Prakash Goud, Faculty Member and the support of National Resource Persons, Mr. Nilendu Mukherjee and Mr. Gautam Mazumder. Ms. Lavanya, Young Professional (SED) and the SVEP Implementation team provided essential background support to ensure the study's successful completion in the field.

In addition to the qualitative data gathered through discussions and interviews, the study also aimed to collect Entrepreneur Data from 1,200 samples. This additional data would provide further insights for the preparation of a comprehensive evaluation report on the program's effectiveness and impact.
