Strengthening of MSMEs: Need for Policy Interventions

The State Government support for micro and small enterprises was limited in recent years. Many State Governments established a separate Department to give full-fledged support for MSMEs. The Government needs to create a separate MSME Department to encourage innovators, skilled personnel and women to set-up Micro and Small Enterprises apart from providing extended services for existing MSMEs. Some of the policy interventions suggested are as follows

It is mandatory to have an empowered committee headed by the Minister of Industries and members from the Department of MSME, Department of Rural Development, Department of Women & Child Welfare, Department of Food Processing, Department of Employment & Training, Department of Textiles & Handlooms, Department of Tourism, Department of Social Welfare and Department of Skill Development for effective implementation of State and Union Government schemes and take convergence initiatives for monitoring and management.

The Micro & Small entrepreneurs are not willing to spend huge amounts on the preparation of a Project Profile to take up their preferred industrial activity. The Government has to provide loans for SC/ST/OBC communities through channel partners of NBCFDC, NSFDC, NSTFDC of Ministry of Social Justice, Govt. of India which will reduce interest burden for SC/ST/OBC operated micro and small enterprises.

To recruit District Level Managers, enough mentors, and business facilitators on a contractual basis for a minimum period of 5 years to support existing enterprises and facilitate potential entrepreneurs as well as innovators as per their requirements. At DIC level a dedicated team, including a Mentor, Business Facilitator, and Industrial Promotion Officer shall be made available to support the entrepreneur in the preparation of the Project Profile and provide mentoring and support services.

To involve senior entrepreneurs and retired officials from various Departments to share their experiences as well as to extend their mentoring services for MSMEs. To encourage large enterprises to support rural MSMEs through CSR fund. The Government has to strengthen Industry Associations and must have sector-specific Industry-Academia-Government networks to promote new enterprises and attend to issues of existing enterprises. To focus on rural tourism, medical tourism, and agri-tourism by implementing a policy.

Physically challenged and Women-centric (single women/widows) food processing & textile clusters and retail clusters need to be established. Youth empowerment through cluster of activities (management of public infrastructure, waste management, skill training, e-services) to be initiated and encouraged. A policy to establish Livelihood Business Incubators (LBI) and Technology Business Incubators (TBI) in all Districts will help to stop migration.

The Government needs to reduce the fixed cost of electricity bills for MSMEs as most of the micro and small enterprises operate with few machineries during the production process at a time, not all machinery.

Youth Policy to encourage youth to participate in social development by way of promoting social enterprises. To make it compulsory for 3rd/4th year engineering graduates to work with MSMEs during their projects. The National Institute for MSME along with UNIDO has initiated to support rice milling and textile units to improve the thermal energy efficiency of industrial boilers.ni-msme has supported the establishment of rural/agro/food clusters across the nation and organized Entrepreneurship and Skill Development Programs.

ni-msme has been catering to the capacity Building and skilling needs of Maharashtra, Karnataka, Sikkim and Telangana states under Raising & Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP) scheme sponsored by Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India.

The EAEC will also provide comprehensive support services, including market research, logistics solutions, digital marketing training, access to funding and global marketplace through a unique blend of seamless academia-industry collaboration.
- **ii)** Centre of Excellence for MSME Enablement of Technology (COMET) is being set up, in collaboration with IIT-Hyderabad, at ni-msme, Hyderabad to facilitate MSMEs with inter-disciplinary, design-focused technologies that would enable them to be global players with indigenous technology development. This proposed Centre will be a platform for Technology Development, Testing, Demonstration and Certification for MSMEs, with digital cataloguing and will be B2B Marketplace for technologies. It will also facilitate MSMEs in developing the energy efficient Technologies apart from solving their existing technological problems. 
