Training on Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluation of Clusters

The National Resource Center for Cluster Development (NRCD) of **ni-msme** had conducted a training programme on Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluation of Cluster Development Program for a duration of Three days from 09 January to 11 January 2023. Total 21 participants from Mothkur Ikkat Handloom cluster, Sus Garment Cluster, Hoshiyarpur Wooden Inlay Cluster, Ieeza Gadwal Handloom Cluster and Sakoli Bamboo cluster were participated in the programme. The Program Director, Mr. K. Surya Prakash Goud welcomed Dr. S. Glory Swarupa, Director General, participants and NRCD team and explained the objectives of the programme. He has mentioned that all the cluster members have to present status of SFURTI project including physical and financial progress and plan of action for completion of pending activities.

Hand embroidery is considered one of the most popular techniques to decorate apparel and other items. Hence, there is a huge demand for trained personnel in hand embroidery.
