India has been assisting in this area by helping to increase the skills of healthcare professionals and promoting the use of digital technology.

The value of Indian wellness industryis estimated at Rs. 49,000 crore (US\$ 6.70 billion)is gaining momentum on the back of Government focus on building a healthy and fit India. Ayurveda is an alternative medicine system with historical roots in India. The Indian wellness and ayurveda industries go hand in hand. Ayurveda is globally acclaimed for its preventive healthcare properties and treatment of many chronic lifestyle disorders. The Indian ayurveda industry has several large players, with the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) capturing 80% market share. Ayurveda is witnessing a resurgence in India because people have accepted this as a way of life as opposed to the earlier notion of ayurveda as an alternative area of medicine.

Healthcare has become one of the largest sectors of the Indian economy, in terms of both revenue and employment. It has been growing at a CAGR of 22% since 2016, employing 4.7 million people directly. The sector has the potential to generate 2.7 million additional jobs in India between 2017-22 over 500,000 new jobs per year. To further boost the industry, Board of Ayurveda (BoA) and Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine (CCRUM), Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India has made an agreement with **ni-msme** for acceleration of traditional medicine industries as well as promotion of Unani clusters.

The invention is about a system for drying Agri Commodities that comprises a net hoisted at "One Foot above Ground Level on wooden/ metal posts

as 'H' structure at the farm location." This system effectively utilizes the SUN - AIR drying medium for drying and prevents the Agri commodities

from the contact of soil-borne contamination and FOG/MIST/DEW-RAIN damage during the drying process, providing superior quality, safe, and hygienic food for human consumption.

# **Scientific Honey Beekeeping Training**

ni-msme conducted one-week training programe on Scientific Beekeeping sponsored by National Bee Board, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India. These programs were held at various locations, including KVK, Sonepur, Odisha, **ni-msme** campus in Hyderabad, Telangana, and KVK, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh. #### 4. MDP on Renewable Energy Sources in Agriculture & Allied Sectors

Anthony Vinay, Principal, St. Mary's Centenary College of Management, Secunderabad inaugurated the programe. # **Refresher Training Programmes**

#### i) Office Procedures and Management:

DG, **ni-msme** highlighted the importance of branding and packaging strategies for enhancing agricultural productivity and income. The program aimed to improve resources, market opportunities, and access for farmers and stakeholders. Certificates were awarded to the participants.

### Creating Wealth from Waste Agricultural and Household Waste
