GRADUATING MICRO, SMALL & MEDIUM ENTERPRISES

The MSME sector is an important sector of the Indian economy. As per data from the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, as on 22 February 2023, the Udyam Registration portal registered 2,10,84,242 MSMEs, replacing the former process of filing for a Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum (UAM). Registered microenterprises stood at 13,834,411 (96.12%), followed by small enterprises at 446,980 (3.11%) and midsized enterprises at 40,400 (0.28%).

As per the information received from Central Statistics Office, Ministry of Statistics

& PI, share of MSME Gross Value Added (GVA) in All India Gross Domestic Product at current prices (2011-12) for the year 2018-19 and 2019-20 were 30.5% and 30.0% respectively. The share of the MSME manufacturing in All India manufacturing gross value output during the year 2018-19 and 2019-20 were 36.9% and 36.9% respectively. As per the information received from Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence and Statistics, the share of export of specified MSME related products to All India exports during 2019-20 and 2020-21 was 49.8% and 49.5% respectively.

The ministry of MSME may consider establishing a MSME Think Tank to carry out research on following important national priorities as suggested by the Hon'ble Union Minister for MSME, Govt. of India:

- 1. Graduating
- 2. Enhancing MSME contribution to National GDP
- 3. Increasing contribution of MSME to Indian exports
- 4. Increasing productivity of MSME work force

The National Institute for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (ni-msme) is proposing to host MSME Think Tank for guiding and advising the Government on policies and strategies for the MSME sector for achieving the aforesaid national priorities by:

Strengthening its Research Capabilities: ni-msme can strengthen its research capabilities by hiring more qualified researchers, investing in research infrastructure, and collaborating with other research institutions. This will allow ni-msme to produce high-quality research that can be aligned to meet national priorities.

Building a Network of Experts: ni-msme can build a network of experts by reaching out to industry leaders, academics, and other stakeholders. This will allow ni-msme to tap into the expertise of these individuals to provide insights and directions.

Providing Policy Advice: ni-msme can advise to the Ministry by conducting research on key MSME issues and identifying best practices. This will help the Government to develop policies that are effective in developing the MSME sector.

Advocating for the Interests of MSMEs: ni-msme can advocate for the interests of MSMEs by engaging with the Government and other stakeholders. This will help to ensure that the voices of MSMEs are heard and that their needs are considered in policy decisions.

Applications of Solar Technologies in Agriculture and Allied Sectors






EDP on Food Processing
